Everyone who attends the St. Rose of Lima Confirmation Track II Retreat is expected to participate actively and behave appropriately so that all attending have the opportunity to safely enjoy this special weekend of ministry! It is best if we all know the expectations going in. The student's participation at the Track II Confirmation Retreat is one of the most important indicators of sincerity and preparedness for the Sacrament of Confirmation. If the student chooses not to demonstrate this sincerity through respectful participation, additional time may be necessary for him/her to prepare for the Sacrament.

- What not to bring Any devices that will prevent you from being fully present to God, and from being able to actively participate in the event, including but not limited to, Cell phones, Ipods, tablets, or laptops. This weekend your time should be spent on deepening your relationship with God. When these devices are present so is the temptation to text, email, chat, etc. Please keep this temptation away from this beautiful retreat experience. (Cameras are permitted only during free time.) Devices that become an impediment with be surrendered to a Leader and returned at the conclusion of the weekend.
- Respect for property Property of the Camp and surrounding areas shall not be damaged, marked or vandalized in any way. All Camp Rules and Regulations must be adhered to. Personal property shall not be damaged or borrowed without permission. Any violation of Camp Rules will require a Candidate to be picked up by a parent.
- Concern for safety and respect for the law No non-prescription drugs or alcohol may be consumed, or
 in any student's possession, at any time. No threats, verbal or physical, abusive or profane language, sarcastic
 or inappropriate comments or horseplay will be permitted or tolerated.
- Cooperation and participation This opportunity will be most beneficial if we respect each other and participate fully. Everyone's cooperation will be important throughout the retreat, including times when participants are expected to be together and when quiet time is needed for sleep. I will be respectful of others ideas and opinions. I understand that I need to arrive on time and remain until the conclusion of the retreat.

If one of these guidelines is not adhered to, appropriate action shall be taken. One possible action shall be that the student(s) involved shall have his/her parents or guardian called and arrangements for immediate transportation home shall be required. In the unfortunate event a student is unable to complete the retreat for any reason, we are unable to extend a refund; the student shall be required to locate, attend and pay for a makeup retreat. In addition, a meeting with parent(s) and student shall be arranged to determine other possible action, for example, destruction of property shall require retribution in the form of the repayment of damages.
