May the Holy Spirit, who dwells within us through our Baptism, shine through our interactions within our family and through our encounters with others.

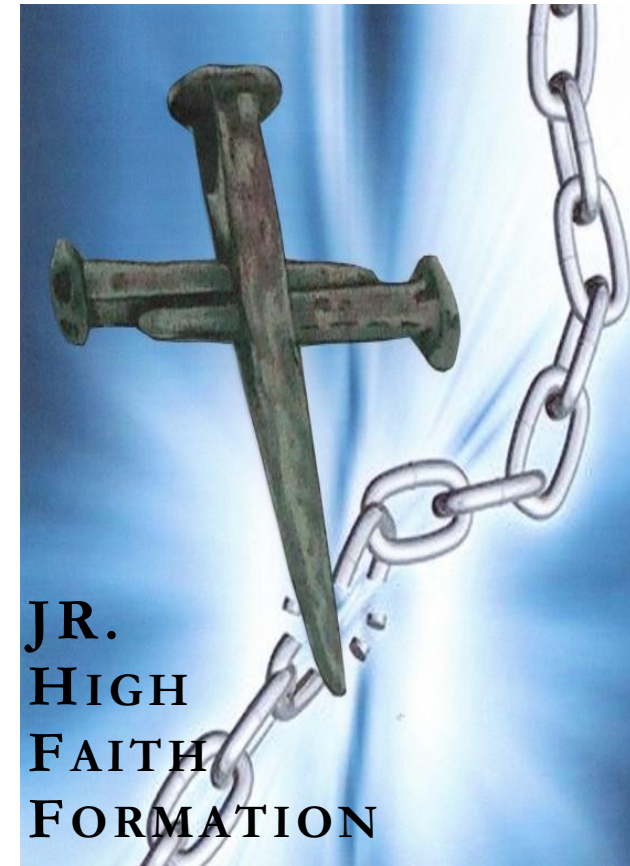

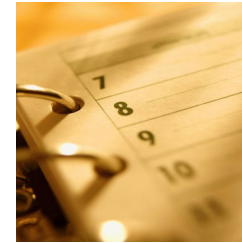
